








Fababean surfaces


have increased between 2012 and 2017 in the European Union almost reach 700 000 hectares

¹EU-28 ²Outside the European Union ³Production + imports - exports


Feed, first market for fababeans

Fababeans are incorporated in compound feed by feed companies or used on the farm. The level of incorporation is low compared to cereals and oilseed meals that are available in larger amounts. On-farm consumption could represent 70% of the production in Germany, 25% in France and 15% in the United Kingdom and Spain⁴.



Perspectives in food market development

In France and in Germany, fababeans are also used as flour in bakery. Fababeans are not often fractioned (in proteins, starch and fibers) but the development of the global plant protein market and the changes in diets that include more vegetables could represent opportunities. Fababean proteins can be used for their nutritional and technological properties by food companies. In Egypt, fababeans are consumed as whole grains, crushed dehulled grains or flour for the preparation of falafels.





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
