


Field pea surfaces




The European Union is the third world producer of field peas

Feed is the main market

In the European Union, field peas are incorporated in compound feed by feed companies or used on the farm. The level of incorporation is low compared to cereals and oilseed meals that are available in larger amounts. On farm consumption could represent 55 % of the production in Germany, 20 % in Spain 4 and 20 % in France.







Perspectives in food market development

Some field peas are fractioned in proteins, starch, and fibers. Field pea proteins are used for their nutritional and technological properties by food companies. The world market of field pea protein is booming.

In India, Pakistan and Bangladesh, yellow field peas are often imported to replaced chickpeas because they are more expensive. They are used as grains (dhal of split peas) or as flour for the preparation of salty and spicy cakes.
